

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

The steps for application and admission to N.E.W. Lutheran High School are listed below. Should you have any questions, please contact the school at (920) 469-6810.

1. Complete the "Application for Admission" and New Student Questionnaire" forms found on this website. They must be signed by parents, student, and pastor of an association congregation, if applicable. The completed forms should be mailed to or dropped off at the school along with the \$200 non-refundable deposit.
2. New freshmen need to take a placement test. Please call the school to schedule. At that time, a tentative class schedule will be arranged. Results of that test and class schedule will be verified with parents through our guidance department in May and June.
3. All non-freshmen transfer students must enroll in the first two weeks of a semester. Transferring students must arrange an interview with school administration to provide information on current status and circumstances. A tentative class schedule may be set up at that time. WIAA guidelines will be followed for transfer students.
4. Don't let finances be a stumbling block – come talk to us. Financial aid is available for those families who qualify for financial help. All grants are considered on a need basis. New students to the school may also apply for a "Scholarship 26" Grant – a one-time scholarship of up to \$500. Grant and Scholarship applications are available in the office and must be submitted to the office by June 1.
5. Current health and immunization records must be submitted to the school along with academic records from your prior school. **All freshmen need a physical examination. Juniors who are involved in athletics also need an examination.** WIAA forms are available from the office.
6. Students entering at the beginning of the school year should attend the student orientation in August. Schedules will be finalized and details regarding bussing, student handbook policies, etc. will be discussed.
