### 2012-2013 TUITION INFORMATION

Students are charged ONE comprehensive Tuition Rate that includes text books, equipment, standardized testing, admission to all athletic events on our campus (except for State Playoff contests), and a fixed amount for student activities and for the class treasury.

*~Students who are certified by a Pastor of one of the Association congregations are eligible to receive the Association Student Tuition Rate. These congregations collectively own and operate this school; they have constructed our campus and together provide over \$100,000 annually towards the operation of the school.*

**A non-refundable fee of \$100 will be required at the time of registration.** This \$100 will *not* be applied towards tuition. If a student decides not to attend, the \$100 will be forfeited. **After April 1<sup>st</sup>, the registration fee increases to \$250 (applicable to returning families only).**

**Other Fees:** All students that participate in Athletic programs are charged \$75 for each sport. This fee is due at the beginning of each season. Some specialized courses (i.e. Art or college-level courses) have an additional fee to cover the cost of fees, or consumable materials and supplies. These fees vary and will reflect actual school expenditures. They are added to student accounts after the semester has begun.

**\*\*Volunteer Fee:** (updated for 2012-13) As a non-profit organization, volunteers are a critical part of our ministry. Therefore, 25 hours of adult service are required from each family. 10 of these hours must be designated towards one of the following: Dinner Auction, Wine Tasting Event, Blazer Open Golf Outing or Blazer Backer Committee involvement. You may opt out of this service by paying a \$450 fee.

**\*\*Technology Use Fee:** (new this year) \$275 per student will be designated for the 1 to 1 iPad initiative. This fee can be paid in full at time of registration or it can be absorbed into the tuition payment plans 2 – 4 listed below.

**Withdrawal:** Any student withdrawing after the first six weeks of school will be charged the tuition for the full semester.

Four payment schedules are offered. Parents select a payment plan at final registration time each year.

1. **Annual Plan:** Tuition is due on July 1, 2012, 2% discount paid in full.
2. **Semester Plan:** Tuition is due in two installments on August 15, 2012 and January 15, 2013
3. **Quarterly Plan:** Tuition is due in four installments on August 15 and October 15, 2012 and January 15 and March 15, 2013.
4. **Monthly Plan:** Tuition is due monthly July 2012 – June 2013 on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month. *This plan automatically withdraws monthly (ACH) from your account.*

*As noted above, tuition does not reflect the full cost of providing a quality Christian education. All students benefit from the generous gifts of individuals and organizations committed to our ministry. Our projected budgeted cost per student for the 2012-2013 school year is \$8,100. This amount is for operating expenses only and does not include capital projects. If you believe the Lord has blessed you with the financial resources, we ask you to prayerfully consider making a donation to cover the difference between the cost of educating your student and the actual tuition you will be billed. If you are not able to make a contribution for the full difference, any amount you are able to contribute will help make a quality Christian education available to more families.*
