

SPIRITUAL LIFE

NEWLHS is a Christian school – the religious instruction of the school has always been consistent with the LCMS doctrine. Faith development is a priority - students and faculty have daily devotions and prayers, attend weekly chapel and assembly services, outdoor worship center and periodic small group Bible studies. There are also men’s and women’s Bible studies offered outside of the school day. Various service opportunities (Service Days) are coordinated for the student body. This is in addition to the Religious classes that are held daily.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Extra-curriculars have often been called the “other half of education.” NEWLHS offers a wide range of activities in which the students can get involved, under the direction of Christian leaders.

Among others, we have a Student Council, Yearbook staff, National Honor Society, Academic teams, Drama Productions, School Newspaper, and Forensics. There is a music program that takes place not only in the student’s schedule but also before or after school with a large variety to choose from: Stage One Choir, Pep Band, Alethia (Praise Band), and Solo-ensemble to name a few.

ATHLETICS

The interscholastic athletic program seeks to offer a wide variety of opportunities for the participant to learn about their own and others’ abilities, winning and losing, techniques and skills, teamwork, fair play and sportsmanship, sacrifice, and other God-pleasing qualities.

Our teams include: Girls Volleyball (Fall), Girls Golf (Fall), Boys and Girls Cross Country (Fall), Boys Soccer (Fall), 8-Man Football (Fall), Boys and Girls Basketball (Winter), Baseball (Spring), Boys Golf (Spring), Softball (Spring), Girls Soccer (Spring) Boys & Girls Track & Field (Spring).

To be eligible to participate as a member of an athletic team at NEWLHS, a student must be registered by the start of the school year, in good standing with the school, and follow WIAA standards. Athletes must express that they are proud to be a member of an athletic squad at NEWLHS through their action in the classroom, at school, and in the community. We compete in the Packerland Conference in all sports except Football (Peninsula Conference) and Girls Golf (Bay Conference).
