

FACILITIES

N.E.W. Lutheran High School is located on the East side of Green Bay, (southeast of East Towne Mall and across from Wilder Park) at 1311 S. Robinson Avenue. The facilities measures almost 38,000 square feet which includes the almost 9,000 square foot addition in the Spring of 2022. The facility includes classrooms, a gymnasium, cafeteria/commons area, computer lab, science lab, 3-D printing room, music room, tech-ed room, locker and weight rooms. Outside the school on the 13.7 acres of land is a soccer field and baseball/softball diamonds – some of which becomes the football field in the Fall. The land abuts a Green Bay conservancy area and with cooperation from the city of Green Bay this has been designated a 17-acre school forest for outdoor classroom use.

FACULTY

We currently have a professional faculty of 8 Called teachers, and 5 additional full time teachers. Our teaching staff has over 225 years of teaching or administrative experience.

HISTORY

N.E.W. Lutheran High School was incorporated in 1976 and began classes in 1977. The school first rented space at Pilgrim Lutheran Church until 1981. Then it leased rooms at the old Norwood School on 9th Street until 1989 when it shared space at Premontre High School. After one year, it transferred over to the old St. Joseph Academy until 1993 when the current facility was finally built.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

NEWLHS prides itself in its academic program. Smaller class size allows for more teacher assistance which aids the individual learner. Students are encouraged and challenged to make the most of their academic opportunities within the classroom. The guidance department encourages proper academic preparation and active participation in high school to prepare them for post-secondary situations.

Approximately **95% of our students enter post-secondary schools, the armed services or trade schools** with 70% of those enrolling at a wide variety of public and private four-year colleges or universities. Graduates also find success at the technical colleges. Traditionally about **two thirds of our graduates receive scholarships** to further their education.

To assist students in making appropriate career and post-secondary choices, a pro-active testing program has been implemented. The American College Testing Service battery of tests are utilized for assessing students' academic ability and achievement. The College Board PSAT is also administered. The Career Occupational Preference System and Armed Services Vocational Ability Battery are used to identify students' career interests and abilities. **Our five-year ACT composite was 23.1 compared to state average 20.8 and national 20.9**. *We were recipients of the ACT Red Quill Award in 2008 and the Red Quill Legacy Award in 2011.*

ACCREDITATION

N.E.W. Lutheran High School was accredited by both the NLSA (National Lutheran School Accreditation) and the NCA-CASI (North Central Association – Commission on Accreditation for School Improvement) in 2019.
