

### Sharing God's Message of Love

"Hark the voice of Jesus crying, Who will go and work today? Who will answer, gladly saying, Here am I, send me, send me!" These are lines from a familiar mission hymn. However, if you are like this writer, the thought of stepping out of a comfort zone and going to a distant land can be a bit intimidating. *How fortunate the NEWLHS school family has been to have an international mission field on our own campus!* This year 16 students from these countries—Germany, Spain, Japan, Switzerland, South Korea, Nepal, Vietnam and Colombia—are part of the international community at NEWLHS. In the past fifteen years, approximately 350 international students from 30 countries have attended NEWLHS! What an awesome opportunity to share the love of Jesus Christ, as the Savior of all, with these students!

This school year, the international students mingle with their American peers in the halls of NEWLHS to absorb American culture, improve their English skills, and receive a well-rounded academic education. As part of their academic instruction, all students are in religion classes, weekly chapel and hear devotions in classes as well as participate in student led devotional hours (LIFT Groups). For many of the international students, this is the first time they have heard the message of Christ's work of salvation. While we may never know the end results of the seeds being planted, we are reassured by the words of the prophet Isaiah, "..so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire." Isaiah 55:11.

Like their American counterparts, the international students at NEWLHS are active beyond the classroom by participating in the music, drama and athletic programs. They come not only from a variety of countries and cultures but from diverse socioeconomic backgrounds and all with their own unique personalities. Host families have the awesome opportunity to model and share Christ's love every day as they integrate the international students into their families. It truly becomes and experience of a lifetime and, prayerfully, for some, an eternal lifetime.
