Admission Requirements for International and Foreign Exchange Students

- Foreign exchange/international students must have completed the equivalent of at least eighth grade, be at least 14 years-old but not more than 18 years-old.
- Foreign exchange/international students are to be proficient in reading, writing, and speaking English. On campus and at school activities, foreign exchange/international students are expected to communicate only in English to improve communication skills and to more quickly assimilate into U.S. culture. Unless a CSIET approved program certifies the student's English proficiency, the TOEFL or TOEFL Jr. exam is required. See TOEFL.org for test information. (Minimum scores TOEFL 70, TOEFL Jr. 745). Other English proficiency testing options may be considered. Other testing options include iTEP (3.5 minimum), IELTS (5.5 minimum), IBT (260 minimum), or a personal Skype interview.
- Foreign exchange/international students attending NEWLHS will not earn a NEWLHS diploma unless all graduation requirements are met. However, all exchange students/international will receive a certificate of attendance and may be eligible to participate in graduation exercises.
- Foreign exchange/international students must pay tuition and fees to attend NEWLHS. Housing expenses and personal spending money are the responsibility of the student. Students are also required to provide their own iPad.
- Foreign exchange/international students are required to take a religion class each semester in attendance.
- > Foreign exchange/international students are to comply with all federal, state, and local laws.
- Foreign exchange/international students under the age of 18 may NOT take driver's education or drive a motorized vehicle.
- Foreign exchange/international students are encouraged to participate in co-curricular activities. As a member of the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association, only students who have attended NEWLHS for more than one year or are participants of a CSIET approved exchange program will be eligible for varsity competition. WIAA requires all student athletes to have a Sports Physical completed in the U.S.
- Northeastern Wisconsin Lutheran High School will apply for the SEVIS(I-20) Form for F-1 visa international students after the receipt of the following information:
 - Completed Application Form
 - Copy of academic records/transcripts(grades 6 and beyond), translated into English
 - Proof of English Language competency scores
 - Completed Physical Form
 - Completed Immunization records
 - Proof of Health Insurance/Permission to Treat
 - Photocopy of Passport
