## Graduation Requirements: Additional Notes

Twenty-six (26) credits are required for earning a high school diploma. The following courses and credits are required:

**Accounting** is offered every other year. This is offered when graduating year is even: 2027-2028, 2029-2030, etc.

**Fantasy Literature** is offered every other year. It will be offered again Fall 2026.

**Mythology & Folklore** is offered every other year. It will be offered again Fall 2027.

**Drama Speech** is offered every other year depending on interest.

**Drafting** is not offered every year.

## Physical Education

Senior students may waive .5 credits of the physical education requirement if both of the following conditions are satisfied:

1. The student will have completed six seasons of interscholastic athletics prior to senior year.
2. The student will participate in at least two interscholastic athletics during senior year.

## Dual Credit Opportunities and Details

**PreCalc:** If taking PreCalc for dual enrollment through UWGB, students must earn a B or higher to earn UWGB credit.

**Statistics:** If taking Statistics for dual enrollment through UWGB, students must earn a B or higher to earn UWGB credit.

**Calculus:** If taking Calculus for dual enrollment, students must earn a C or higher in MATH 104 or pass the UWGB placement exam.
